A primitive three-legged oak cricket table with round plank top; Rustic rural small circular table on splay stick legs. The round top displays a rich patina and desirable antique wear overall. [1. Cricket tables originated in rural England and were versatile, often used for household tasks such as serving tea, holding candles, or playing card games. A tripod

base would offered stability on uneven surfaces. These tables originated in rural England. Their practical design made them a staple in 18th and 19th-century English cottages. Cricket tables were typically made from locally sourced woods like oak and built to withstand everyday use. The round top and three-legged design of these tables reflect the simplicity and functionality of rural furniture.]
