A Swedish Rococo gilt bronze mounted tulipwood, walnut and parquetry bombé commode, mid 18th century.

Sylven, *Mästarnas Möbler*, Stockholm, 1996, p. 115, p. 69, p. 273, p. 276 and p. 361)]
